Thank you for connecting with the Occupational Therapy Institute (OTI) for your rehabilitation services, consultations, referrals or as a community partner. In 2021, OTI opened with a pilot program to provide services to patients as well as a valuable clinical experience to graduate students in the Salus University Department of Occupational Therapy. The pilot program was successful; however, we do not have the funding needed to move to the next stage of this program.

We have, therefore, made the decision to discontinue the OTI services effective June 30, 2023.

Should funding become available in the future, we would be happy to explore the reestablishment of this program.

If you are currently receiving services, those services will continue as scheduled through the rest of the Spring semester, until May 2023. Additionally, for those receiving services and those on our waitlist, please work with your referring doctor, primary occupational therapist or insurance company to locate a facility to continue your care.
